Entry for Adults all classes \$20.00.

Entry for Reined Cowhorse - \$40.00 (includes cattle fee)

*Cowhorse class will be dependant on availability of cattle for the show.

Riders may ride more than one horse in each class but may be limited depending on entries. Horses may only run **once** in each class.

Arena will be available for use from Wednesday 8th May to Saturday morning until 7.30 am.

All riders must be current CSRHC Members or Event Members.

SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

<u>ALL COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:</u> If you are not a member of the Calliope Sliders <u>you must</u> fill in a Membership Form & pay an Event Membership fee of \$25 with your entries.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ALL HORSES ALREADY ENTERED. LATE FEES APPLY TO NEW ENTRIES (CLASS FEE + \$10) PER CLASS.

Dress for this show should be neat and tidy and suitable for riding eg jeans, long sleeve shirt, riding boots, brimmed hat or Helmet compliant with AS3838. All Youth Riders must wear a helmet.

This is a schooling show and we understand that riders may want to school on their horses during their run. Please be mindful of your time in the pen and animal welfare. Any excessive schooling or extension of time in the pen and you will be asked to leave the pen.

Reining Etiquette for Arena use. Left Circles at the far end of the arena, right circles at gate end of arena. Circles & turnarounds for first half of the hour. Rundowns, stops and rollbacks for second half of the hour. Horses are not to be rested at the centre of the arena. Move to the centre of the circle for spins. Please ensure you check behind before backing.

ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS IS DEEMED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES

Numbers to be worn by all competitors. Numbers will be supplied by the club and will need to be returned at the end of the day.

- 1. No liability accepted for loss of or damage to animals, persons or property.
- 2. ALL DOGS MUST REMAIN ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.
- 3. Please clean up all manure & place in designated areas.
- 4. Please advise if you have any stallions and we will ensure they have a yard that is safe for them and all other competitors.
- 5. **Headstalls and Bits** For all classes headstalls and bits must be compliant with the rules of the NRHA eg no nosebands or tie downs, no use of whips or bats. Snaffle bit **must not** be twisted wire or thinner than 3/8".
- 6. Tie for 1st In the event of a tie for first WINNER WILL BE DECIDED BY TOSS OF COIN

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Open Ranch/ Open Reining – Open to ANY horse/rider combination.

Non Pro - Full pattern as written. Open to any Non Professional Rider. Any Horse.

Green Reiner – Horse to be ridden one or two handed but must remain consistent throughout the whole pattern or a score of zero(0) will be given. Any approved bit, any gear, restricted to **riders** that have not won **3 events** at any affiliate reining show. Simple lead change may be used without penalty. If the need arises the rider may touch the saddle with their hand without penalty. Pattern 5A is pattern 5 without Maneuvre 5(figure 8)

Novice Horse – Full pattern, one hand with shank bit or two handed in a snaffle. Open to any rider on a horse that has less than \$1000 in NRHA earnings.

YouthRider/ Under 18 — One or two hands regardless of age of horse, any gear, must be 18 years or under. Simple lead changes may be used without penalty.

Rookie – Full pattern. Rider to have less than \$300 in NRHA earnings. One handed in a shank bit or Junior Horse in a snaffle bit. Western gear, western attire.

Green Horse – Horse to have less than \$200 in NRHA earnings. May be ridden 2 handed in any bit or hackamore. Simple lead changes are allowed.

Beginner Rider/ Beginner Horse – Horse and or rider must be new to reining. This pattern is designed to allow riders to get the feel for reining patterns without having a trained reining horse. It contains elements used to teach reining maneuvres, replacing the actual maneuvres.

Beginner Ranch – For horses & riders new to Ranch. May be ridden one or two handed in a snaffle or bridle. Lope section of the pattern will be replaced with trot & extended trot. Pen work with the cow may be omitted or you may have someone work the gate for you. You are required to walk into the pen and walk quietly around the cattle and back out again without disturbing the cattle.

Sliders Feature Class – Open to ALL horses & riders. One or two handed. Green Horses & Green Riders may perform a simple lead change. This is to give riders the opportunity to ride one of NRHA's new Lope In Patterns.

Reined Cowhorse Event – Will be run dependant on availability of cattle. Open to any rider. Horse can be ridden one or two handed in a snaffle, bit or hackamore. Saddle horn can be held during the boxing stage if required. Cow will be let into the arena at the completion of the dry pattern. Cow will be boxed only. NO DOWN THE FENCE.
