



CSRHC and SQS NRHA Oceania Qld State Show

Show Conditions & Rules

1. The Show is **NRHA** approved.
2. Entries will be returned if all documentation is not provided.
3. A rider can only show a maximum of 3 horses in any NRHA Sanctioned Class.
4. All NRHA/CSRHC/SQS Memberships and Horse registrations and NRHA Licences **MUST** be sent with nominations to showsecretary.csrhc@gmail.com.
5. NRHA rules apply to all NRHA riders and classes and non sanctioned classes except where otherwise indicated. NRHA stewardship still applies to ALL horses competing in the show.
6. Non Sanctioned classes – Rider must be a Full or Event member of CSRHC or SQS to compete in these classes. Proof of membership is required and must be sent to showsecretary.csrhc@gmail.com or Event membership to be selected with nominations.
7. NRHA Classes – Both owners and riders must be current NRHA members to compete in NRHA classes. Horses must have a valid NRHA competition licence to compete in NRHA classes. Proof of membership and horse licence is required. All competitors must also be a Full or Event member of CSRHC or SQS, to compete in NRHA classes. Event membership can be selected with nominations.
8. Rookie 1 and 2 may also use a horse without restrictions of ownership as per the NRHA Handbook.
9. NRHA Green Reiner- NRHA Association membership is required, no NRHA licence is required for the horse. Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership defined in Non Pro Conditions. Owner must have General NRHA Membership at minimum.
10. Barry Delbridge/Platinum Saddle Co. Memorial Ride – Open to all, any handed..
11. Non Pros must hold a non-pro card or complete a Non Pro Declaration form with their entry. NRHA Non Pro horse ownership rules apply unless otherwise stipulated.
12. Facility/Open Pen Fee must be paid with nominations, and back number must be visible on horse whilst riding in the arena. Failure to display the correct number or no number will incur a \$25 fine.
13. Competitors entering concurrent classes will pay only 1 judges' fee
14. Bank details **MUST** be provided for all Payouts, please email all bank details to showsecretary.csrhc@gmail.com
15. All riders under 18yrs old must have a Liability Waiver Form signed and completed by their guardian.
16. All dogs **MUST** always be on a lead. It is the owner's responsibility to always ensure safety and wellbeing of the dog.
17. **BUMP IN** will be from Monday 17th August If any exhibitors require earlier check in please contact the Show Rep: Ed Smith 0404 465 280.
18. **Paid Times: Paid Warmups are on a first pay first serve basis.**
19. **Horses MUST wear a number at all times when being ridden.**
20. Limit 2 slots (either together or split. 5 min/slot) per horse. Paid Times are for horses competing only.

1. 4yr Old Futurity – Horse must be shown one handed in any legal bridle. Eligible competitors able to nominate in Level 2 and 3 are not required to nominate in the Level 4 class.
2. 5 – 8yr Old Derby – Horse must be shown one handed in any legal bridle. Eligible competitors able to nominate in Level 2 and 3 are not required to nominate in the Level 4 class.
3. 3 yr Old Snaffle Bit Hackamore– Horses must be shown two handed in any legal snaffle bit/Hackamore.

Penalties, Fines & Refunds

1. Stables & Camping must be reserved through Nominate and booked 48 business hours prior to arrival to avoid a Late Fee. Scratches will be accompanied by a vet certificate and received prior to closing of nominations 30th July, will receive their stabling & nominations back less office & facility fees. Scratching's received after the draw has been completed, will NOT receive a refund of their entry fees, even with a vet certificate.
2. Any competitor that enters in a class for which they are ineligible will incur a \$50 fine. NRHA Eligibilities can be checked on NRHA Reiner Suite. If in doubt, contact the Show Secretary.

Payouts

1. NRHA payback percentages will be used to calculate payouts unless otherwise stipulated.
2. CSRHC/SQS will retain 50% of entry fees except where otherwise stipulated by NRHA rules for each class.
3. Payouts will be paid via eft within 30 days of the show after confirmation of results is received from NRHA. Please ensure the competitor's bank details are sent with nominations to avoid delays.

Eligibility

1. It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of their earnings and enter classes accordingly. Eligibility criteria are explained in the class list provided in the Show Package for all classes and are as of Jan 1st 2026
2. CSRHC/SQS classes earnings equal to ALL monies earnt at ANY reining event.
3. NRHA classes use NRHA earnings only, which are monies earned in an NRHA approved event.
4. Horse Age is taken as horses age as at 1st Jan 2026. Derby horses are 5,6,7,8-year-olds.

Beginner Series

1. Riders must be members of an NRHA Affiliate.
2. Riders must still be eligible for NRHA Green Reiner.
3. Riders cannot enter any sanctioned classes other than Green Reiner or Youth
4. Horses do not need to be licensed or owned by the rider

Junior Horse

1. For horses 4 years and under.
2. May be ridden 2 hands in a snaffle bit or 1 handed in a bridle

Senior Horse

1. For horses 5 years and over.
2. Must be ridden 1 handed in a bridle.

Entries

1. Late entries for previously nominated horses will be taken up to 4pm the day before the class. At that point entry for the next day will be closed. No exceptions. Late entry fee of \$25 per class. Horses will run last. No entry will be accepted from any horse that has not been previously approved nominations for the event.
2. Draws will be posted 10pm for next day classes. Draws may differ from the program if late entries are received. Please check the draws posted for late entries & scratchings.
3. An indemnity & liability form must be completed by all competitors.

4. Horse Health Declaration must be completed & submitted at the show office or with nominations.

Arena Availability

1. A maximum of 14 horses will only be allowed at any one time in the arena. Any additional horses will have to wait until another horse exits the arena prior to entering.
2. Show management reserves the right to close the pen for arena maintenance at any time they deem necessary.
3. Every horse on the grounds (stabled or day only) will be charged a Facility Fee/day. Failure to pay the appropriate fees will receive an invoice after the show for any discrepancies.
4. Open pen rules apply. Circles at top half of hour. Left at the gate, right at far end. Stops at bottom half of the hour. No stopping in the centre. Be aware of horses around you before backing or schooling.
5. At the entry of the tractor to the arena at any time ALL horses must move to the side of the pen and remain stationary or leave the pen while the drag is taking place.
6. No Lunging in the show pen or in the warm up area near the covered arena.

Show Management

1. Any concerns must be directed to the NRHA Show Manager Ed Smith or Show Representative – Brendan Manz. Any official complaints must be in writing and comply with the NRHA Rulebook along with a \$250 filing fee.
2. **No mistreatment or abuse of a horse will be tolerated. No over schooling of horses will be tolerated.**
3. All competitors and spectators must always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner and conduct themselves as per the NRHA Handbook.
4. Show management decisions will be final and binding.
5. All horses being ridden must be in full tack while on the grounds – exception the Freestyle class. Riding double or bareback is not allowed.
6. Any incidents or injuries to be reported immediately. Safety Officer on ground is Scott Hergest.
